- **Fine Artists** who wish to participate in this event will need to send an email to washingtoncityartscouncil@gmail.com with the completed application along with five high-quality images of their artwork for screening.
- **Galleries, Museums, and Art Organizations** will need to submit an application to include a contact name along with a brief (30-50 words) description of your business/organization, along with five images o
- All tents must be white, 10’x10’, and need to be set up by 9 a.m. and remain in place until 6 p.m. (**no early takedowns**).
- **No-Show policy:** Artists who have not checked in and have failed to alert the committee at least 48 hours prior to the event forfeit their assigned space and event fees.
- All participants are encouraged to provide a live demo during the event.
- All participants are encouraged to provide a piece of art or an item of value (ie: a certificate for a free workshop, or membership) for the prize drawings throughout the day. This is added marketing value for you.
- You are responsible for processing your own sales and paying your sales tax. No commission is collected.
- Please provide us with one of the following—required by the State of Utah: Social Security Number (SSN), Employer Identification Number (EIN), Utah Sales tax number OR driver’s license and date of birth; or if you’ve previously been assigned a Special Event Account Number (SSE). _____
- Artwork must be original in design and executed by the applicant. Each artist must accompany their own work and may display and sell only in the category in which their work has been accepted.
- Original artwork must occupy more than 50% of the booth display. Limited edition prints—individually labeled as such, may be sold only if signed.
- Artists display at their own risk. Artists must keep their area clean and orderly throughout the entire event.
- There are no refunds due to inclement weather, late cancellations, an act of God, local authority, or related natural disasters.
- The committee reserves the right to reject any work it considers unsuitable.
- No commercial dealers, agents, kits, castings from commercial molds, mass-produced items, or buy/sell allowed.
